THE CAESAR TOWER

Symbol of the Count of Champagne's power, this dungeon built in the 12th century had many functions : watch tower, prison, bell-tower...

THE PROVINS MUSEUM

Housed in Provins' oldest house (12th century), it presents many works of art belonging to Provins and its neighborhood from Neolithic times to the 19th century.

THE TITHE BARN

This typical Provins house with its superb vaulted cellar used to be rented to the merchants of Toulouse when they came to town for the Champagne Fairs. The scenography brings to life the main crafts and merchants of this time.

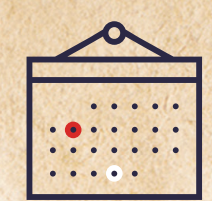

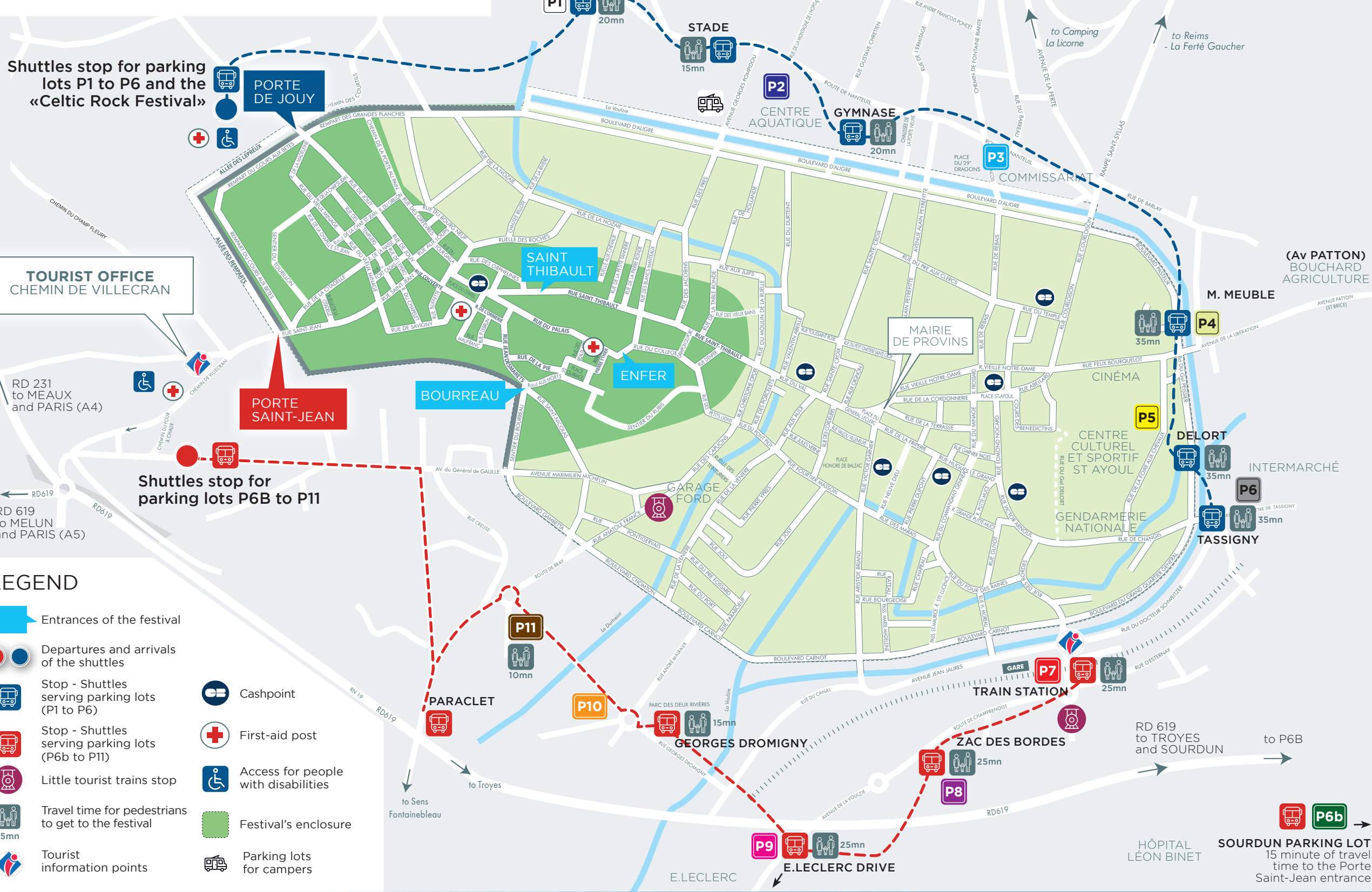

ACCESS MAP - PARKING LOTS - SHUTTLES



FESTIVAL ACCESS



SHUTTLES

Free shuttles will run between the various parking lots and the festival site. On Saturday from 9:15 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. (last shuttle at 12:30 a.m.), on Sunday from 9:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. One shuttle every 20 minutes.

To return to the PARKING LOTS P1 TO P6, take the shuttle from PORTE DE JOUY.

To return to the PARKING LOTS P6B TO P11, take the shuttle from AVENUE ANATOLE FRANCE (FORD GARAGE).

Remember to retain the number and the color of your parking lot.

TO GO TO THE "CELTIC ROCK FESTIVAL" ON SATURDAY: From the festival site, take the special shuttle "Festival Rock Celtique" at PORTE DE JOUY running from 7 P.M.

At the end of the show, a shuttle will take you back and serve all parking lots on demand.



PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND REDUCED MOBILITY

TOURIST TRAIN

Some LITTLE TOURIST TRAINS (CHARGED) will run in the lower town FROM 10 A.M. TO 7 P.M. continuously from PROVINS' TRAIN STATION TO AVENUE ANATOLE FRANCE (FORD GARAGE). Access to the festival by the ENTRANCES "BOURREAU" or "ENFER". Prices: 2€ the one-way ticket / Free for children under 5 years old.



CAMPER

The camper parking area next to the Tourist Office is exceptionally closed for the festival. A free area for campers will be at your disposal from the previous THURSDAY AFTERNOON until the end of the festival. There will be road signs to guide you from the Tourist Office to your area.

To benefit from the reduced rate, your medieval costume should be complete: headpiece, pants, top and shoes! Costume of fantastic inspiration is accepted. You can buy or rent one in specialized shops but also buy one in Provins!



PETS

Pets are not permitted within the perimeters of the medieval festival.



IN CASE OF HOT WEATHER CONDITIONS

Put your headpiece on (the medieval cap)! And keep hydrated! 4 first-aid posts are set up on the festival site.

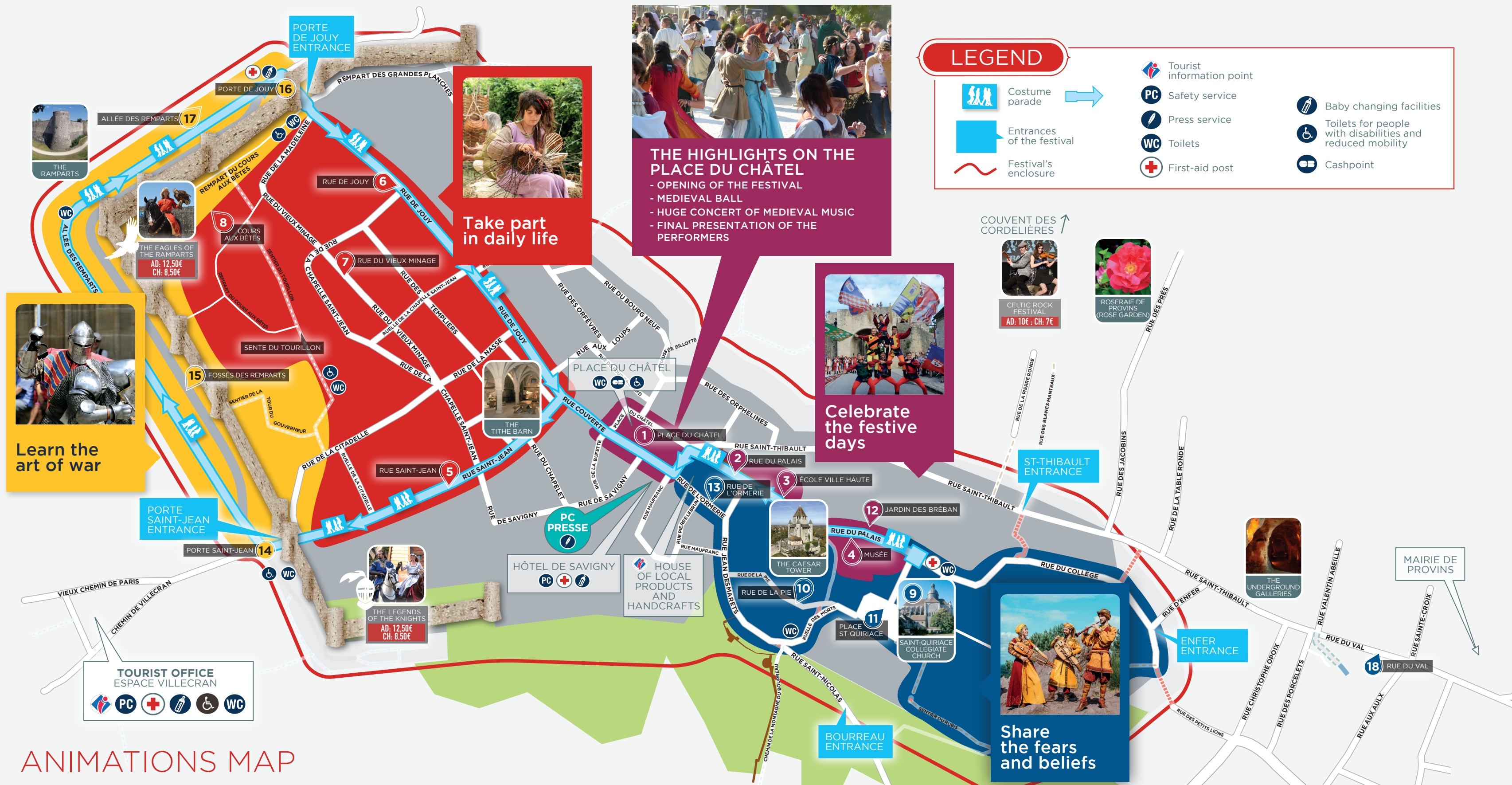
Cth GUEULE DE LOUP
