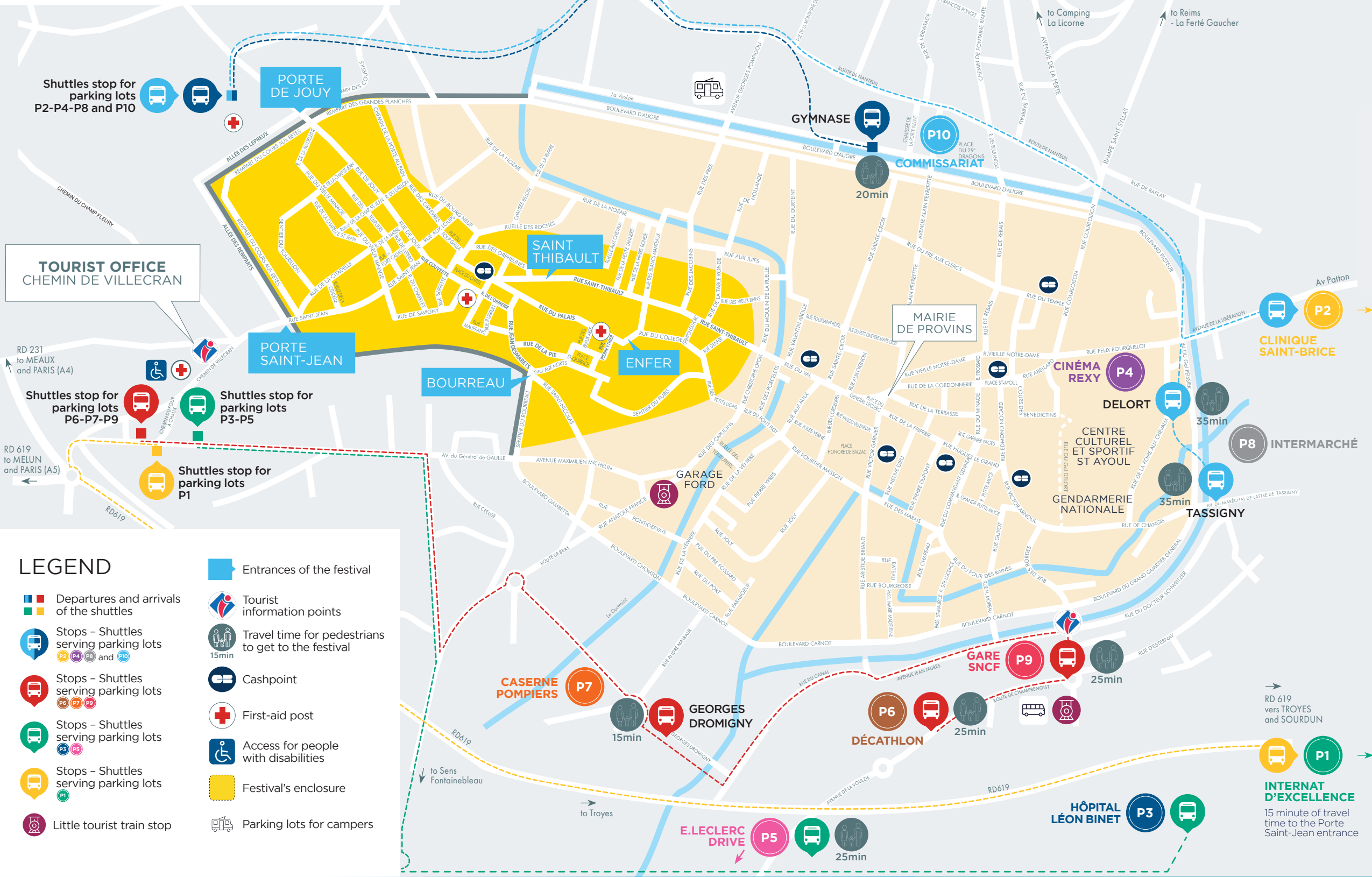

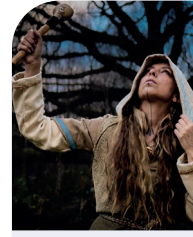

THE CAESAR TOWER

Symbol of the Count of Champagne's power, this dungeon built in the 12th century had many functions : watch tower, prison, bell-tower...

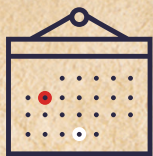

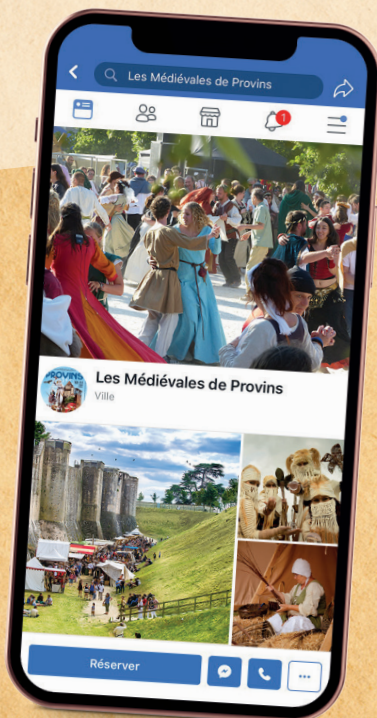
