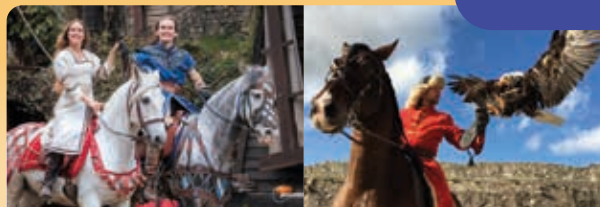

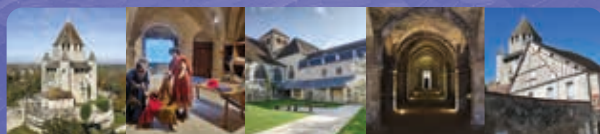
ANIMATION: "LÉGENDES ET CROYANCES"

BY BUS

Stop "Ville Haute" at the Tourist Office.

PARKING AND SHUTTLES

Many free parking lots are available. Free shuttles buses will run between the various parking lots and the Festival site.



BY ROAD

A4 Motorway: Paris-Metz-Nancy, exit 13 Serris-Provins, then follow the road D231

N4: main road for Nancy, exit Provins, then follow the road D231

D619 (ex N19):

Troyes - Provins, exit Provins

A5 Motorway:

> direction Paris to Troyes, exit 16 Châtillon-la-Borde, take the D408 and then the D619.

> direction Troyes to Paris, exit 17 Forges, then the D210, then the D403 via Donnemarie-Dontilly and follow signs for Provins.

A6 Motorway:

> direction Lyon to Paris, interchange A19 to Sens, then the N6 to Pont-sur-Yonne and D976 to Bray-sur-Seine, thereafter follow signs to Provins.

Meet quirky arms merchants, discover the art of brass work, blacksmithing or calligraphy...

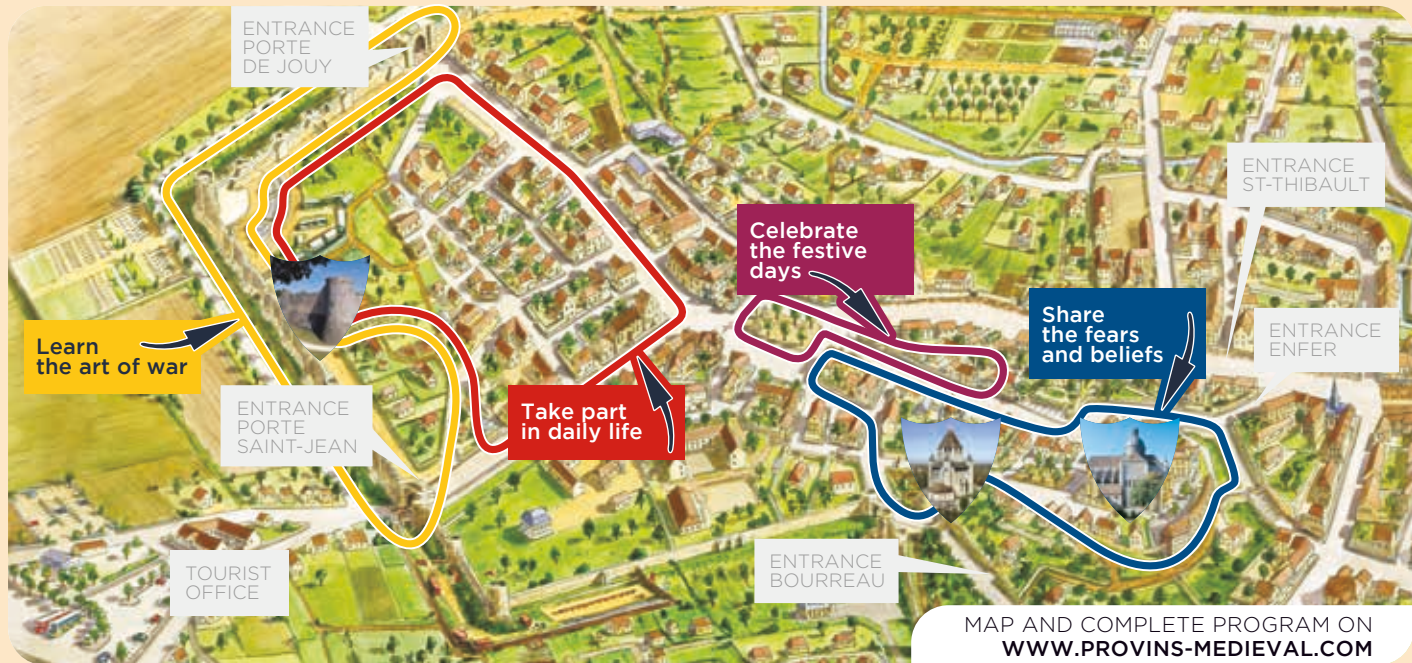
During jousting re-enactments, you will observe tactics and techniques of yesteryear. Tales of bravery and combat demonstrations will captivate the bravest knight!
